

# Glacier National Park retracts boat quarantine on Lake McDonald

Glacier National Park is retracting an announcement made July 10 regarding the third phase of its aquatic invasive species emergency response. The press release reads:



The previous announcement that the park will release quarantine and inspection procedures for people living outside the park who would like to launch their boat on Lake McDonald was premature and was not directed by the Department of the Interior as some news organizations reported.

The park will allow private landowners living within the park boundary whose motorboats are only launched on Lake McDonald to access the lake. These boats have exceeded the thirty day quarantine requirement, and in addition, have undergone a rigorous aquatic invasive species boat inspection by NPS staff.

Over the next few weeks, the park will release quarantine and inspection procedures for people living outside the park who would like to launch their boat on Lake McDonald.
